## **Community Forest Advisory Board Meeting**

**MEETING MINUTES** 

Wednesday, May 13, 2020 Meeting held by videoconference call

1. **Call to Order** Anne Fege, Chair, called the meeting to order at 10:20 am

3. **Approval of Minutes** The minutes of February 12, 2020 were approved.

## 4. Announcements and Updates

- a. Anne Fege reported on FY 2021 budget hearings, including email messages submitted one-minute statements made for Parks, Sustainability and Transportation departments. Seven councilmembers verbally opposed reduction of tree maintenance funds. Proposed reduction is for tree maintenance contract funds.
- b. Brian Widener described the policies and details for board meetings being held by videoconference, according to state-wide modifications of Brown Act requirements.

#### 5. Discussion

a. Chris Drayer reported the City's inspection of tree and sidewalk in front of his property and recommended that the sidewalk be modified instead of removing the tree.

### 6. City Staff Reports

- a. Brian Widener described current work conditions, horticulturalists mostly working remotely and tree crews working in the field. Contractors are only doing tree removals, on emergency basis. Tree maintenance needs to continue, but fewer requests are being submitted in "Get it done" software.
- b. Widener presented the monthly report of urban forestry activities since July. Progress continues, for integration of tree maintenance data with City databases.
