1. Call to Order Anne Fege, Chair, called the meeting to order at 10:10 am

3. Approval of Minutes The minutes of May 13, 2020 were approved.

5. Discussion

- a. Moriah Saldaña gave an update for the next five years of the Climate Action Plan. A public forum was held on August 13, and nine more online forums are scheduled for this fall for each district. A draft CAP is scheduled for release in early 2021 for public comment.
- b. The City has developed a Climate Equity Index, to apply to City programs. Lowerincome districts may have less tree cover and may have fewer sites for tree planting. Additional investments could increase these sites by planting in street rights-of-way (not just parkways), investing in pavement removal, and expanding tree watering approaches. CFAB members from districts 4, 8 and 9 will bring suggestions to the next meeting.
- c. Trees might be removed to build accessory dwelling units (ADUs) without provisions for replanting, thus reducing neighborhood tree cover. There may be no requirement to include a tree with the addition of the ADU. Further research into the existing City Landscaping requirements is needed.

6. City Staff Reports

- a. Brian Widener gave an update on tree maintenance, tree planting with CalFire grants in the Otay-Nestor area, and removal of palms killed by the South American palm weevil.
- b. Widener reported that US Forest Service tree inventory work is displayed at <u>https://mct.tfs.tamu.edu/</u>.
- c. Magen Shaw expressed concerns about development projects affecting parks, that some are approved without tree protection during construction.
