

FEMA Disaster Relief Assistance Secured – Three Ways to Apply






FEMA

Federal disaster assistance is now available to San Diego County individuals to supplement recovery efforts in the areas affected by severe storms and flash flooding from Jan. 21-23, 2024.

Assistance can include grants for temporary housing and home repairs, low-interest loans to cover uninsured property losses and other programs to help individuals and business owners recover from the effects of the disaster.

You can begin applying for this assistance now in one of three ways:

Starting Feb. 22, FEMA staff will be canvassing the affected areas informing residents of new federal assistance available through the agency.

FEMA will offer individual assistance to qualifying residents and businesses who were suffered losses from storm-related flooding. They will target the most affected areas and individuals, including those in emergency lodging situations.

Residents and business owners who sustained losses in the designated areas can begin applying for assistance at: **DisasterAssistance.gov**, by calling **800-621-FEMA (3362)**, or by using the FEMA App.
