BOTTOM SCRATCHERS First Spearfishing Club formed in La Jolla

"The Bottom Scratchers, organized in 1933, is the oldest and most exclusive skin-diving club in the world. In forty-five years, the group has accepted only nineteen members. [All have passed]. In the sport of diving, which they freely admit to inventing, there is no more prestigious a title than Bottom Scratcher. <u>They are the grandfathers of scuba diving because</u> <u>they are the fathers of skin diving.</u> The club's members developed or discovered the fundamental equipment and techniques for encountering the ocean beneath its surface, and in so doing unzipped it for the probing and hungry hands of future generations."
