A **MOTION** to approve the following changes to the Marvin Elementary Joint Use permits as written below was made by 1<sup>st</sup> Terry Cords, with a 2<sup>nd</sup> provided by Martin Marcus.

The hours and operations for permits to end at 6pm on Weekdays until the start of daylight savings time, then for the months of May through September weekday permits to end at 6:30pm. Permits for the weekends, no games start before 10am – no games start after 4pm. No more than 2 teams playing on the field at the same time. Games to be staggered to ensure 2 team limit (no teams warming up adjacent to homes}. The Rec Council/CRG will revisit the Marvin operational changes at their July 2024 or September 2024 meetings to see how things are going. It is noted that some frustration was expressed that there were no consequences for user groups who violated the terms of their permit. It was discussed that there be a 3 infraction and you're out consequence. The motion passed unanimously.
