This impactful resolution project started in 2017 is aimed at bridging archival gaps. To date 36,802 resolutions have been preserved through digitization.

Closing the gap in historical records and digitizing them, including resolutions, not only preserves our collective heritage but also empowers present and future generations with comprehensive insights into our past, fostering informed decision-making, understanding, and a stronger sense of identity and continuity.

Additionally, the microfilm rescan project aims to digitize the Resolution Microfilm collection, with rigorous quality control measures in place.

Approximately 7,287 pages, totaling 489 hours of work, have been quality controlled, representing 42% completion. This effort prioritizes archival best practices by re-digitizing poor-quality images.

Gentlemen

Enclosed please find letter addressed to you by Reverend Roy Campbell which is self-explanatory.

May I add my request to that of Reverend Campbell asking you to be good enough to sanction the activities of our organization, which will consist of selling flowers on downtown street corners of San Diego on December 10th and 11th using as a medium young Ladles of Chinese parentage.

Medless to say, your cooperation in the matter will be greatly appreciated by our committee, which consists of some of the most prominent citizens of our city.

Most gratefully your M. C. PFEFFERKORN Chairman

This petition proposed by the Chinese Relief Committee of the American Red Cross in 1937 aimed to fundraise by selling flowers on the streets to relieve the women and children of China under the distress of war.
