I. SUMMARY

The Privacy Advisory Board ("PAB") recommends that the City Council approve the proposal related to the above-referenced technology.

II. RECOMMENDATION

The PAB recommends that the City Council approve the proposal.

III. DISCUSSION

The PAB compared the beach camera data from other large metropolitan areas with surveillance systems, bringing context to the decision to modernize the City of San Diego's surveillance capabilities:

San Clemente, CA – Beach Camera for major incident response

Long Beach, CA – Beach cameras for major incident response

New York, NY – \$398.4 million budget and UASI Surveillance Cameras in that budget for counter-terrorism and crime prevention

Boston, MA - \$3.1 million dedicated to UASI Surveillance Cameras for major incident response and threat operations.

For the above stated reasons, the Privacy Advisory Board recommends that the City Council **approve the proposal** above.
