FOOD RESOURCES FOR FLOOD VICTIMS

San Diego County residents impacted by the Jan. 21-23 severe storms may qualify for food assistance.

Disaster CalFresh Benefits

This program provides a one-time payment to eligible residents to buy food for themselves and their families.

Residents affected by the flood can apply between March 7-15, 2024. Residents already receiving CalFresh also may be eligible for the Disaster CalFresh benefit.

To apply for this one-time payment, you must:

- Live or work in the disaster area.
- Buy or plan to buy eligible food.
- Be experiencing challenges due to the disaster.

Eligibility requirements depend on your net income (total monthly take-home income after taxes, all payroll withholding, and any liquid resources), the number of people in your home and other disaster related expenses.
