

CONSTRUCTION NOTICE:

Pure Water Pipeline Work to Begin on Genesee Avenue from Luigi Terrace towards Centurion Square for the Morena Northern Pipelines and Tunnels Project

On **Saturday, March 23**, traffic along a segment of Genesee Avenue will shift into the northbound lanes for the construction of the City of San Diego Morena Northern Pipelines and Tunnels project in University City.

This new section of pipeline construction will include traffic control setup and pipeline construction between Centurion Square and Luigi Terrace.

Construction crews will be installing one 48-inch wastewater pipeline and one 30-inch brine pipeline in a 13-foot-wide trench through the Southbound lanes of Genesee Ave. and in a tunnel under the railroad tracks in Rose Canyon. Traffic will be diverted into the Northbound lanes around the construction zone to maintain two-way traffic on Genesee Avenue. Please see the map on Page 2 for details on the traffic control plan.

Working hours for this segment of pipeline installation and tunnel work will be Monday through Friday from 7 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. Construction will start in mid-March and continue through Fall 2024. Two-way traffic will be maintained at all times.

Please plan extra time when traveling on Genesee Avenue. University City High School students and parents can use the entrance at Centurion Square and the student gate during the morning school commute/drop-off. The student entry will remain open for easier access.

The City and project team are committed to completing construction as efficiently as possible with safety as our highest priority, and the community's patience and coordination are appreciated.

What to Expect:

- Two-way traffic on Genesee Avenue will remain.
- 24/7 access for emergency vehicles, residences and businesses will be maintained.
- For safety reasons, please follow all posted signage. Please anticipate traffic delays, construction noise and overnight construction lights.

Why: Pure Water San Diego is the City of San Diego's phased, multi-year program that will provide nearly half of San Diego's water supply locally by 2035. The Pure Water San Diego Program will use proven water purification technology to clean recycled water to produce safe, high-quality drinking water. The Program offers a cost-effective investment for San Diego's water needs and will provide a reliable, sustainable water supply. The Morena Northern Pipelines and Tunnels project is one of several major water infrastructure projects in Phase 1 of Pure Water San Diego.

The City is committed to clear communication and providing up-to-date information about construction activities. Properties along the construction area will receive printed notices before work begins near their address, and construction notices will be regularly posted on utc.purewatersd.org.
