#### Reminder: Work at Morena Blvd. and Sherman St. Starts Tonight

Starting at 8 p.m. tonight, Feb. 29, crews on the Morena Conveyance South & Middle and Conveyance Bike Lanes Project will begin work to install two major pipelines through the Morena Boulevard and Sherman Street intersection. Phased construction is scheduled through March 2024 with full intersection closures occurring 24 hours per day on weekends and nighttime construction on weekdays. Outlined below are the construction schedule and a map displaying traffic access during weekend intersection closures.

Traffic control will be in place to ensure public safety and give crews a safe space to work. Access for businesses and residents will be maintained, with detours in place during weekend work. For your safety, please follow all posted signage including posted detours. Please plan extra time when traveling in the area to accommodate for traffic delays, and please anticipate construction noise and overnight construction. Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times.

#### Construction Schedule:

Crews will be working through March to complete the work as efficiently and safely as possible. The schedule below is subject to change and any schedule changes will be communicated to impacted stakeholders.

**Feb. 29-March 4, 2024:** Full intersection closure from 8 p.m. on Thursday, Feb. 29 to 5 a.m. on Monday, March 4, where detours will be in place. Crews will be working 24 hours per day through the weekend.

**March 4-8, 2024:** Partial intersection closure from 8 p.m. on Monday, March 4 to 5 a.m. on Friday, March 8. Construction is scheduled for four nights from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. Lanes will be limited, but traffic will be maintained through Morena Boulevard and Sherman Street.

**March 8-10, 2024:** No scheduled construction; intersection will be open to traffic.

**March 11-15, 2024:** Partial intersection closure from 8 p.m. on Monday, March 11 to 5 a.m. Friday, March 15. Construction is scheduled for four nights from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. Lanes will be limited, but traffic will be maintained through Morena Boulevard and Sherman Street.

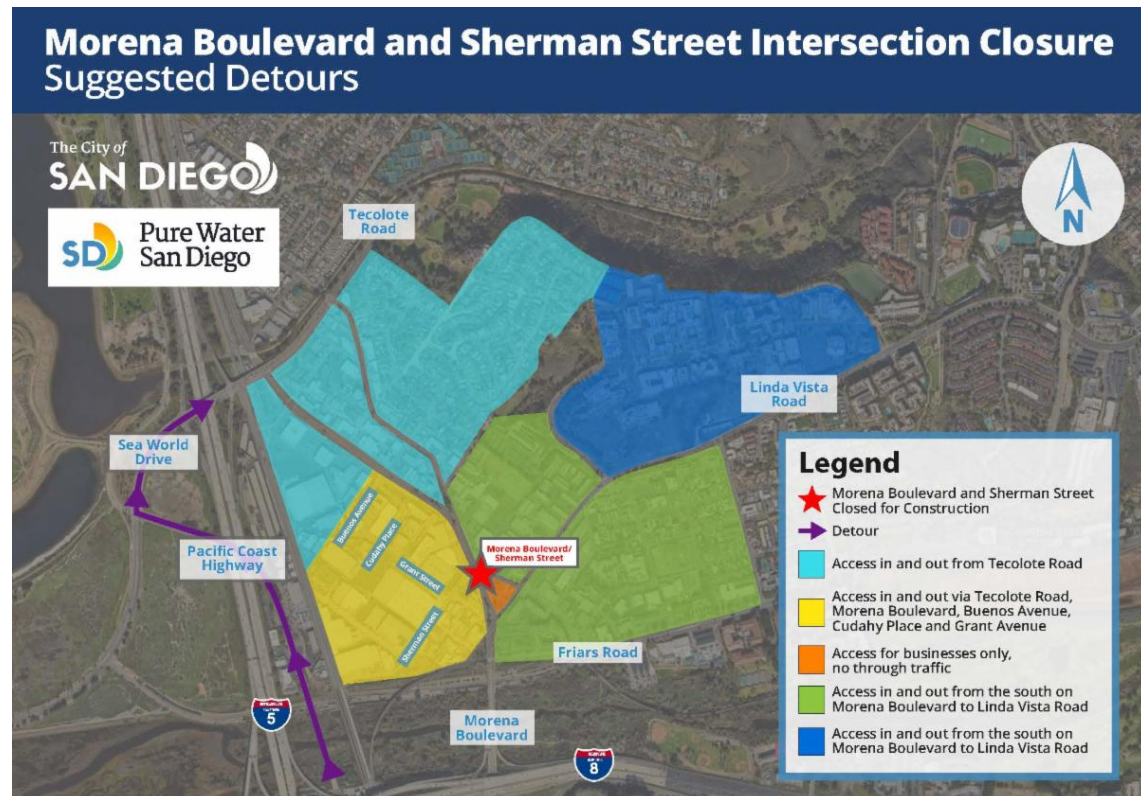
**March 15-18, 2024:** Full intersection closure from 5 a.m. on Friday, March 15, to 5 a.m. on Monday, March 18, where detours will be in place. Crews will be working 24 hours per day

through the weekend.

**March 18-21, 2024:** No scheduled construction; intersection will be open to traffic.

**March 21-25, 2024:** Full intersection closure from 8 p.m. on Thursday, March 21, to 5 a.m. on Monday, March 25, where detours will be in place. Crews will be working 24 hours per day through the weekend.

The map below outlines the routes for vehicles to access the areas around the work zone. These detours will be in effect **during weekend full closures only**. technology to clean recycled water to produce safe, high-quality drinking water. The Program offers a cost-effective investment for San Diego's water needs and will provide a reliable, sustainable water supply.

Phase 1 includes several projects that will clean recycled water to produce 30 million gallons per day (mgd) of high-quality purified water, reducing the City of San Diego's dependence on imported water.
