

# PARKS AND RECREATION DEPARTMENT-PERMIT CENTER Luxury Picnic Permitting Guidelines

The Parks and Recreation Department has several designated locations for luxury picnics. A park-use permit will be required for all picnics regardless of the size.

## **Permitting Guidelines:**

- A park use permit is required
- All permittees must follow all Parks Rules and Regulations
- Provide a copy of certificate of liability with the endorsement page
- Parks & Recreation fees will apply
- Two (2) hour minimum/four (4) hours maximum
- One (1) permitted picnic per day/per location
- Not allowed on City beaches (sand)
- No glass
- No alcohol
- May not impede emergency access points.

#### Fees:

- Ground use fees will apply for all events 50 and over
- Special Equipment Fee: \$24.85/per day/per equipment
- Opportunity Fund Fee: (Less than 50)
  - -Commercial: \$5.18/per hour
  - -Non-Profit/Non-Commercial: \$1.04/per hour

### **OR**-Opportunity Fund Fee: (Over 50)

- -Commercial: \$15.53/per hour
- -Non-Profit/Non-Commercial: 10:36/per hour
