San Diego Police Asking for Community's Help in Locating Sexual Assault Suspect

San Diego – San Diego Police are asking for the community's help in finding the man who broke into a home and sexually assaulted a girl. Officers were called to the 2800 block of Wellington St. in Linda Vista on April 18 at approximately 1:45 a.m. for a report of a hot prowl burglary. Western Division officers responded quickly and learned that a man entered the home through an open door. He then sexually assaulted a girl who was sleeping in the home before taking off.

San Diego Police Child Abuse Unit detectives are investigating the attack. The suspect is described as a White or Hispanic male adult, approximately 5'8" or 5'9" and weighing between 160 to 180 pounds. He was wearing a dark jacket, possibly a windbreaker, and dark pants. The San Diego Police Department is conducting extra patrol in the neighborhood.
