# Comparative Salary Analysis for the City Auditor Position Update

## **OVERVIEW**

In November 2023, the Audit Committee requested our Office provide an update of <u>IBA Report</u> 20-22, *Comparative Salary Analysis for the City Auditor Position*. This report responds to that request. In accordance with San Diego City Charter section 39.1, the Audit Committee must recommend to the City Council the annual compensation of the City Auditor. Effective January 2024, the current salary for the City Auditor is \$258,856<sup>1</sup>. Per the City of San Diego's Salary Ordinance, the salary range for the City Auditor position is between \$92,088 and \$348,840. Under Charter section 39.2, the City Auditor may serve up to two five-year terms or ten years in total. The current City Auditor assumed office about 3.5 years ago, after being appointed in November 2020.

This report provides a comparative salary analysis of chief audit executives at eight jurisdictions within California, as well as three comparably sized cities outside of California. The results of our comparison are presented in Attachment 1 of this report. Other factors which can be considered in assessing auditor compensation are also briefly discussed in this report.

# FISCAL AND POLICY DISCUSSION

#### Comparative Salary Analysis (see Attachment)

Attachment 1 of this report provides a comparative analysis of executive auditor positions within California and select, comparable cities outside of the State. Attachment 1 also provides an overview of the operations of other jurisdiction's auditors including: the number of budgeted positions within the department or division, the number of years that the chief executive auditor

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>1</sup> The <u>proposed FY 2025 Salary Ordinance</u>, which is scheduled for its first reading at the April 8, 2024 City Council meeting, includes two salary increases for unrepresented City employees, which includes the City Auditor: a 4% increase effective July, 1, 2024, and a subsequent 2% increase effective January 1, 2025. Absent any additional discretionary increases, the City Auditor's annual salary will be approximately \$269,214 effective July 1, 2024, and approximately \$274,602 effective January 1, 2025.

has served in the position, and the size of the jurisdiction's total budget (operational and capital) for Fiscal Year 2024. The salary data provided in Attachment 1 reflects the base salary of the chief executive auditor positions and excludes other forms of compensation such as pension, healthcare coverage, and other employee benefits.

#### Other Factors That Can Be Considered in Assessing Compensation

Our Office selected the chief audit executive positions for comparison based on the nature of internal audit work performed in each jurisdiction. Though the work may be comparatively similar in terms of processes and protocols, it is important to note that organizational differences and circumstances surrounding internal audit operations may vary from one agency to the next. For instance, by nature of San Francisco being both a city and county, the San Francisco Director of Audits performs auditing functions for departments that may not have counterparts in the City of San Diego, such as their Human Services Agency and their Department of Public Health. Important factors to be considered in determining City Auditor compensation include the experience, accomplishments, and achievements of the chief audit executive. Other factors that can be considered include compensation relative to comparable executive appointees in the organization, size and complexity of the organization's audit operation, and other executive benefits (e.g., pension, healthcare, paid leave, holidays).

# CONCLUSION

The IBA has conducted a comparison of base salary and related data for chief audit executives at eleven comparable public agencies. Auditor compensation data and other related information, such as budgeted audit positions and time in service, are presented in Attachment 1 of this report. The IBA makes no recommendation regarding the appropriate level of compensation for the City Auditor.
