## NOTICE OF RIGHT TO APPEAL ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION

**PROJECT NAME/NUMBER:** Consent to Sublicense between Canyonside Equestrian Center, Inc. and

Horsebound, LLC

**PROJECT DESCRIPTION:** Consent to Sublicense to an agreement between Canyonside Equestrian Center, Inc. ("Licensor") and Horsebound, LLC ("Licensee") allowing Licensee to sublease a portion of the premises leased to Licensor. The Sublicense allows the Licensee the following uses: (a) non-exclusive use of the main arena and the dressage area for instructing members of the general public in the care, maintenance and horse riding equines, (b) exclusive use of the lower pasture, (c) exclusive use of the existing office building and staging area, and (d) for parking of equine transportation on the License Area. This Consent is in satisfaction of the requirements to Section 3.3 of the City of San Diego License Agreement dated February 23, 2023, between the City and Licensee.

**ENTITY CONSIDERING PROJECT APPROVAL:** City of San Diego

**ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION:** Categorically exempt from CEQA pursuant to State CEQA Guidelines Section 15301 (Existing Facilities)

**ENTITY MAKING ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION:** City of San Diego Mayor-Appointed Designee.

## STATEMENT SUPPORTING REASON FOR ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION:

The City of San Diego conducted an environmental review that determined the project would not have the potential for causing a significant effect on the environment pursuant to State CEQA Guidelines Section 15301 (Existing Facilities), which consists of the operation, repair, maintenance, permitting, leasing, licensing, or minor alteration of existing public or private structures, facilities, mechanical equipment, or topographical features, involving negligible or no expansion of existing or former use; and where the exceptions listed in CEQA Guidelines Section 15300.2 would not apply in that no cumulative impacts were identified; no significant effects on the environment were identified; the project is not adjacent to a scenic highway; no historical resources would be affected by the action; and the project was not identified on a list of hazardous waste sites pursuant to Section 65962.5 of the Government Code.

The appeal filing fee must be United States Postal Service (USPS) postmarked before or on the final date of the appeal.
