Morena Conveyance South and Middle Project-wide Update

Crews are continuing to work at three locations on the Morena Conveyance South & Middle and Conveyance Bike Lanes Project. Outlined below are status updates for each portion of work, with working hours and estimated schedules.

As a reminder, initial temporary paving will be installed shortly after crews install new pipeline, and it will then be replaced with final paving in the future. All roads impacted by construction will be paved curb-to-curb and re-striped before the project is completed.

Clairemont Drive and Rappahannock Avenue:

Work to install pipeline is approaching the Clairemont Drive and Rappahannock Avenue intersection, moving northbound on Clairemont Drive. In late April, additional traffic control will be installed overnight and crews will then begin installing pipeline between Rappahannock Avenue and Ute Drive. The project team remains in contact with the schools in the area to mitigate impacts to their operations as much as possible. Crews are working between 7:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. to install pipeline. Welding and other activities to finalize pipeline installation occur between 4:30 p.m. and 11:30 p.m.

Clairemont Drive and Fairfield Street:

Work to install pipeline on Clairemont Drive is moving east/northeast on Clairemont Drive from Fairfield Street towards Burgener Boulevard. This portion of work will be finished in early May once crews reach Burgener Boulevard. Crews are working between 7:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. to install pipeline. Welding and other activities to finalize pipeline installation occur between 4:30 p.m. and 11:30 p.m.

Morena Boulevard and Sherman Street:

Work to install pipeline along Sherman Street has reached the Morena Boulevard and Sherman Street intersection. After installing pipeline within the intersection of Morena Boulevard and Sherman Street, work will proceed north/northwest on West Morena Boulevard. Crews are working between 9 p.m. and 5 a.m., Sunday nights through Thursday nights. Traffic will be maintained through the Morena Boulevard and Sherman Street intersection, though lanes may be reduced.
