The proposed project is a part of a larger system that would expand the existing recycled water distribution system supplied by the North City Water Reclamation Facility along Black Mountain road to the developing Black Mountain Ranch community and the Olivenhain Water District. The proposed pump station would be located just inside the entrance of the Canyonside Community Park located at 12350 Black Mountain Road. The pump station would be constructed below ground, with only the venting system extending above ground level. This venting system would be incorporated into an artist designed trellis walkway that has been developed in coordination with the community park planning group to match the existing recreation center architecture within the Rancho Penasquitos Community Plan area.
