SUBJECT: SMART STREETLIGHTS FOURTH AMENDMENT TRAINING

SCOPE: ALL MEMBERS OF THE DEPARTMENT

DEPARTMENT PROCEDURE AFFECTED: 3.33

Portions of this document are deemed by the San Diego Police Department to be records of security procedures and are exempt from disclosure under the California Public Records Act (CPRA), Government Code Section 7923.600 or are deemed by the San Diego Police Department to be exempt from public disclosure because the public interest served by not disclosing the information clearly outweighs the public interest served by disclosure, pursuant to California Government Code section 7922.000.

Smart Streetlights are a police investigative tool approved by City Council. Department members who use the system will receive ongoing training regarding the Fourth Amendment of the U.S. Constitution. As part of the ongoing training, all Department members shall read the attached Fourth Circuit Court case which involves the prosecution of a murder suspect where critical evidence was obtained using the Smart Streetlights system. The case briefly and clearly outlines Fourth Amendment issues such as expectations of privacy in public places and explains how Smart Streetlights are substantially different from technologies such as cell site location information which require a warrant. The case is *People v. Cartwright*, 99 Cal. App. 5th 98 (2024) . The training will be completed from user's individual Success Factors account.

To review the case, all members will log onto Success Factors via the SDPD intranet.

To access the training, do the following:

1. Using the Google Chrome browser, log onto Success Factors via SDPD Intranet > SDPD Applications > OKTA Login Portal.
2. At the first OKTA screen, select the "SuccessFactors" (Production) tile to access the application and then select the "My Learning" tile to access the learning module.

3. Make sure you see the word “Find Learning” in the upper left corner of the screen. There, you will see a box that contains a search line which reads, “What do you want to LEARN today?” In that search box, type “***Smart Streetlight Fourth Amendment Training.***”
4. A list of courses will show up on your screen. Select “***Smart Streetlight Fourth Amendment Training***” and then click on “***Start Course***” in the lower left corner of the course’s tile.

Then click the blue “***Launch Content***” button on the next screen. The PDF document will load in a new screen. Read the document in its entirety. You must click “***Agree***” at the bottom of the screen or the pop-window to ensure you receive credit for viewing the document. The window will close.

This training shall be completed by Monday, May 1, 2024.
