“Howard Wayne St” Sign Unveiled in Linda Vista to Honor Former Assemblyman

The honorary street sign was unveiled by Councilmember Campillo and the Wayne family following a brief speaking program on Saturday morning at the site of the sign on Morena Blvd

SAN DIEGO — This morning, a new sign honoring the late former Assemblymember Howard Wayne was unveiled to a crowd of about 50 Linda Vista residents, friends and family of Wayne, and others. The honorary sign reads Howard Wayne St and was placed above two Morena Blvd street signs at the intersection of Morena Blvd and Buenos Ave. The honorary street naming does not change the address for any resident, business, or other entity.

“Howard’s passion to make a positive impact wherever he went and with everything he did was an inspiration for so many in the community, myself included,” said San Diego City Councilmember Raul Campillo. **“He truly loved his community, and his community loved him. I’m grateful to be able to celebrate Howard with an honorary street naming in his home neighborhood of Linda Vista.”**

“Howard loved his community and was especially good at getting people to the table to make it better for everyone,” said Felicity Senoski, who served with Howard Wayne on the Linda Vista Community Planning Group from 2014 to 2023 and is now Chair. **“This street naming really honors Howard in a way I am sure would make him proud.”**

Howard Wayne, a beloved member of the Linda Vista community, passed away in November 2023. Over the course of his life, Howard Wayne served as a Deputy Attorney General, State Assemblymember for the 78th District, and Chair of the Linda Vista Planning Group. As Assemblymember, one of his most important accomplishments was passing AB 411, which is related to coastal water-quality testing programs.

The site of the street sign was chosen because Wayne was invested in the Morena Corridor Plan and because his wife lives nearby. Wayne is survived by his wife, Mary, his brother, Robert, and other members of his extended family.
