a. St Augustine review

Project No. <u>PRJ-1107756</u>, NORTH PARK: (Process 2) Substantial Conformance Review pursuant to approved Conditional Use Permit (CUP) No. 8110, Planned Development Permit (PDP) No.34245 (PTS No. 4869), condition No. 10 which states the CUP and corresponding use of this site shall be subject to periodic review every fifth year throughout the life of the permit for compliance with the conditions contained in the permit. The 7.51-acre site is in RS-1-7 zone, within North Park Community Plan area within Council District 3. Code Case No. CE-0524356.

b. PROJECT NO: PRJ-1110314 PROJECT NAME: GROUP JOB 828 SDP Switzer Canyon Stormwater CIP project

Permit for storm drain extension of three (3) existing facilities which collect runoff and discharge into Switzer Canyon. The storm drain facilities are located at the dead end of the following streets: 1) Maple Street East of 28th Street; 2) Olive Street East of 30th Street; and 3) Palm Street West of 32nd Street. The total constructed storm drain pipe is approximately 412 linear feet (LF) and approximately 420 cubic yards of excavation. Each facility will include a new inlet at street level, cleanouts in the canyon, and a discharge structure/energy dissipater at or near canyon floor. The sewer component of the project constructs approximately 9,010 LF of sewer main and approximately 5,042 cubic yards of excavation and installs new and replace existing forty-one (41) manholes.
