How-To Make Resin Letter Keychains

Materials:

- 1. Gloves
- 2. Epoxy resin
- 3. Mask (if you have upper respiratory problems)
- 4. Paper towels
- 5. Silicone letter molds (14.2" x 7.5" preferred)
- 6. Popsicle sticks
- 7. Silicone measuring cups
- Dried flowers or whatever you would like to put in letter mold
- 9. Droplets
- 10. Eye pins
- 11. Hand Drill
- 12. Jump rings
- Keychain ring and lobster claw
- 14. Sand paper or a drill with sanding attachment

CAUTION PLEASE BE IN A VENTILATED AREA

Instruction:

 Measure your resin part A & part B in the Silicone cups (example 10 ml each to equal 20 ml)

- Using your popsicle sticks, stir the resin until well incorporated
- Pour a little amount in each letter mold
- Place the flowers of chose into each letter mold and let it sit until the resin get tacky (about 3-4min.)
- Fill the letters up to the top and let it dry (this might take 24 hour)
- Once your letters dry take them out of the mold
- Use the sand paper or sander to smooth the edges down
- Drill a small hole at the top of your letter to place your eye pin
- Once you have your edges smooth and the hole at the top of your letters, wash and dry your letters to remove all residue
- Place your eye pins into your hole and use a little bit of glue in the hole to secure it in place.
- Once you have your eye pins secure put a jump ring on the eye pin and to the chain.
- Now at the top of the chain add a jump ring to attach your keychain ring and lobster claw and now you're down!!
