#### Logan Ave Series Circuit Grant

#### Funding!

The Logan Ave Series Circuit Conversions project has received \$1.5M in federal grant funding through the Light Up San Diego Streetlight Improvement Program. This infrastructure is outdated which has resulted in low reliability and high maintenance costs to the City. This project will upgrade the outdated series circuit system to an updated parallel lighting system, improving mobility, accessibility, and safety for pedestrians and vehicular traffic. The project is comprised of a total of 29 streetlights.
