CITY HALL UPDATES

SD Housing Commission Assistance for Flood-Affected Households If you or someone you know were affected by the recent storms and associated impacts including flooding—resources are available to assist you.

Financial Assistance for ETLP Families from the City of SD who were ineligible for FEMA

- Assistance for one move for the household, such as:
 - Application Fees
 - Security Deposit (up to two months)
 - Storage Costs
 - Hotel Expenses (up to two weeks for families that executed a lease and awaiting the unit's availability)
 - Moving Costs
 - Up to six months of rent
 - Landlord Leasing Bonus
- Assistance is subject to funding availability.
- Eligibility
 - City of San Diego household eligible for and currently residing in County's ETLP
 - Ineligible for assistance from Federal Emergency
 Management Agency (FEMA)
 - Avoid duplication of benefits
 - Avoid risk of disqualification from ongoing FEMA assistance
 - Assistance from SDHC's program may adversely affect a family's continuing eligibility for further FEMA assistance.
 - FEMA may provide a larger total amount for up to 18 months.

Landlord Housing Restoration
Assistance

- SDHC is exploring a contract with a local nonprofit organization to administer this initiative.
- The nonprofit's responsibilities would include:
 - Assess flood damage at housing units.
 - Contract with labor to complete necessary repairs to restore the unit and makeit habitable.
- SDHC would provide funds from the County to the nonprofit to cover costs for labor and materials.
- Assistance is subject to funding availability.

SDHC Housing Unit Search Assistance

- All City of San Diego households eligible for and participating in the County's ETLP can receive housing search assistance from SDHC.
- SDHC staff experienced in housing searches for other programs will identify available rental housing units within the County of San Diego.
- Housing search workshops conducted to share basics of searching and locating a rental housing unit and information about online leasing platforms.
- Landlords encouraged to list their available units at affordablehousing.com
- The landlord is required to lease the repaired unit to the family that previously occupied the unit.
 - If the previous tenant declines the unit, the landlord is required to rent to another City of San Diego family eligible for and participating in the County ETLP.
- Restrictions on lease terms and contract rent would apply to ensure the displaced family does not experience significant changes to their contract rent amount.
