Fiscal Year 2024 Mission Bay Park Improvement Funds – Reallocation of Funds to Mission Bay Construction Projects, presented by Ryan Barbrick, Program Manager, Parks and Recreation Request the Mission Bay Park Improvement Fund Oversight Committee approve the recommendation to reallocate \$2,186,956.00 of Mission Bay Park Improvement Funds in audited revenues received to the following projects:

- Ventura Comfort Station Improvements, CIP# B18227 \$200,000.00
- South De Anza Basketball Courts and Play Area, CIP# B19173- \$1,100,327.00
- Dusty Rhodes Parking Lot Improvements, CIP# B19158 \$586,629.00
- Crown Point Playground Improvements, CIP# B19021 \$300,000.00

RECOMMENDED BUDGET ALLOCATIONS

Department staff recommends allocating \$2,186,956.00 of MBPIF revenues to the above projects. Funding will come from the following projects:

- \$139,823.36 from B19177 Bonita Cove East Comfort Station. This project was placed on hold during the pandemic due to a revenue shortage. It will remain on hold. Once funding is available, the project can restart design.
- \$226,916.72 from B19178 Bonita Cove East Playground. This project was placed on hold during the pandemic due to a revenue shortage. It will remain on hold. Once funding is available, the project can restart design.
- \$357,709.00 from AGF00004 Mission Bay Improvements from project savings.
- \$50,146.92 from B22039 Bahia Parking Lot and Comfort Station. This project will be put on hold. It was early in design. Once funding is available, the project can restart design.
- \$750,000 from B18223 Adult Fitness Course East Shore. This project is closing and has project savings.
- \$160,000.00 B19029 Santa Clara Playground Improvements. This project is closing and has project savings.
- \$50,000.00 from B19032 Santa Clara Comfort Station Improvements. This project is closing and has project savings.
