Morena Conveyance South & Middle and Morena Conveyance Bike Lanes Project

Within the next week, the City of San Diego will begin nightime pipeline construction on your block as part of the Morena Conveyance South & Middle and Morena Conveyance Bike Lanes project.

What to Expect:

- Installing beams to prepare for future pipeline installation
- One lane in each direction will be maintained, but please follow all traffic control and signage
- Access will be maintained for all businesses, residences and emergency vehicles; crews will accommodate all necessary driveway access
- Please be advised that construction may be loud overnight

Anticipated Construction Schedule:

Work will take place at night between 9 p.m. and 5 a.m., Sunday night through Thursday night. This phase of work is expected to last approximately two weeks.
