

Unfortunately there are many different inequities experienced by youth. Disparities in wages, health, access to higher education, and more persist among youth in San Diego.

OVERCOMING BARRIERS TO SUCCESS

Immigrant Youth/Youth of Immigrant Parents

San Diego County has one of the largest immigrant populations of all US counties. According to San Diego Foundation, nearly 91,000 immigrants in San Diego live in poverty, and this has a negative impact on life outcomes of immigrant youth and youth of immigrant parents.

Foster Care Youth

Youth in the foster care system can experience trauma from being displaced from family and schools and from multiple placements with different families. Being in the foster care system can cause them to fall behind in school, and foster care youth are less likely to finish high school than their peers. Exiting the foster care system can also be a struggle. Many leave with no support or plan for the future, and they are vulnerable to experiencing homelessness when they leave.

Students Without Limits

organization that provides legal, mental health, and continuing education help to underserved minority or immigrant teens. They partner with schools across San Diego to provide these services.

Their Immigrant Youth Program provides after-school workshops to educate youth on immigration policy, connect them to resources, and help with college and scholarships. They have "little family meetings" that provide support and guidance from caring adults.

Resources for Foster Care Youth

San Diego Youth Services has an Independent Living Skills Program that helps youth exiting foster care with finding stable housing, enrolling in college or vocational programs, employment, and other things necessary to become an independent adult.

Foster Youth Coordinating Services Programs
(FYCSPs) support foster youth in a number of ways. They include Tutoring and Tutor Success,
College Connection, and School Success Program,
just to name a few.


Disability Pride Month

somebody because of a disability.
It removes barriers for people
with disabilities to things like
getting jobs and using public
transportation. It also requires
that public accommodations like
wheelchair access is available,
among other benefits.

SUPPORTED EMPLOYMENT RESOURCES

world day for International Justice

JULY 17TH, 2024

HISTORY

International Justice Day commemorates the historic adoption of the Rome Statute on 17 July 1998 and marks the importance of continuing the fight against impunity and bringing justice for the victims of war crimes, crimes against humanity, and genocide. (Das, 2023).

PURPOSE

To enforce the law and defend the interests of the United States according to the law, to ensure public safety against threats foreign and domestic, to provide federal leadership in preventing and controlling crime, to seek just punishment for those guilty of unlawful behavior, and to ensure fair and impartial administration of justice for all Americans. (Das, 2023).





WHAT IS THE CRIMINAL JUSTICE SYSTEM?

The Criminal Justice System is the system that prescribes the fate of the criminal. It is also the system that provides recompense to the victim under the rule of law. Criminal justice seeks to deter future crimes by creating penalties for criminal conduct and rehabilitate criminals through incarceration. (Bureau of Justice Statistics, 2021).

CRIMINAL JUSTICE IMPORTANTANCE

The criminal justice system's goal is to maintain order in society by punishing those who break the law and protecting the welfare of the citizens. This system ensures that suspects are appropriately investigated, prosecuted, and defended to guarantee a fair trial.


