Arrest Made in 2020 Murder in Talmadge

San Diego – On September 18, 2020, at 3:25 a.m., the San Diego Police Communications Center received a 911 call regarding an assault with a deadly weapon in the 4400 block of Euclid Avenue. When the officers arrived on scene, they found a 33-year-old Black male who had sustained trauma to his upper body. The officers began rending aid until relieved by San Diego Fire-Rescue personnel. The man was transported to a local hospital, but unfortunately, he succumbed to his wounds. The man was pronounced deceased at 4:15 a.m. The victim in that case was identified as 33-year-old Mychael Farve of San Diego.

Over the course of several months, Detectives from the from the San Diego Police Homicide Unit investigated this case. During the course of their investigation, Detectives learned Farve had previously been in a relationship with a 25-year-old Hispanic female, Sheila Camarena. On the day of this incident, a confrontation occurred between Camarena and Farve and he was fatally shot. On February 25, 2021, a felony warrant was issued for her arrest for one count of Murder. A Crime Stoppers flier was distributed requesting the public's assistance in locating her.

On July 2, 2024, at 6:18 p.m., Camarena was taken into custody by San Diego Police Detectives at the United States Port of Entry at 720 West San Ysidro Boulevard. Camarena was arrested for her outstanding warrant for Murder and booked into Las Colinas Jail.
