CITY HALL UPDATES

We are excited to announce that the CPPS (Community Projects, Programs and Services) City Council funding program has been renewed for Fiscal Year 2025!

The application will be accessible via the "Application" section below on Monday, July 8, 2024 and will be open until Friday, August 9, 2024.

City Council Community Projects, Programs and Services (CPPS) funds are awarded to nonprofit organizations and public agencies for community, social, environmental, cultural, and recreational needs that serve lawful public purposes. The City Council's CPPS Funding Program is governed by <u>Council Policy 100-06</u>.

Funds granted to nonprofit organizations and public agencies are awarded at the discretion of each Council Office and are paid toward the end of the fiscal year. Each applicant is assigned one of two grades: 1) Qualified, or 2) Not Qualified. An applicant may apply for funding from multiple council offices within a single application. An applicant may submit multiple applications, but each must be for a single project, program, or service. Funding may be awarded by a council office based on a review of the "Qualified" application pool. Funding allocations are expected to be announced in October 2024. All funding awards to nonprofit organizations and public agencies must be approved by the full City Council. To apply please visit: sandiego.gov/citycouncil/cpps
