- Reviewing projects to ensure meeting site landscape requirements: site landscaping, street trees, revegetation/erosion control, street yards, municipal codes, brush management and water conservation
- New: Climate Action Plan(CAP)-gives DSD more power to enforce tree requirements on single family homes when adding ADU's

CFAB Report on Vacancies and Termed Out Positions (Brian Widener)

- D3&D5: no candidates (need to do outreach to Council offices)

Tree Planting Efforts (John Ide)

- 400 trees planted in fiscal year
- Another 200 identified and planted
- FreeTreeSD: around 200 requests come into the Program every 3 months, Arborists evaluate and send to contractor. Longest wait should be about 9 months

APCD: Aiming for 600 trees by end of fiscal year

Arbor Day: April 26, 2024 to be held possibly in D4, D8 or D9
