#### HOW TO SPEAK TO A PARTICULAR ITEM DURING PUBLIC COMMENT:

<u>In Person for Agenda Items and Non-Agenda Public Comment:</u> Please fill out a speaker slip located at the entrance to the meeting. Indicate the item you wish to speak on as well as other requested information. Then submit it to City staff.

<u>Via Virtual Platform for Agenda Items and Non-Agenda Public Comment:</u> When the Hearing Officer introduces the item (or indicates it is time for Non-Agenda Public Comment), raise your hand by either tapping the "Raise Your Hand" button on your computer, tablet, or Smartphone, or by

dialing \*9 on your phone. You will be taken in the order in which you raised your hand. You may only speak once on a particular item.

When the Hearing Officer indicates it is your turn to speak, unmute your phone by tapping the unmute button on your computer, tablet or Smartphone, or dial \*6 on your phone.

**Please Note:** Members of the public who wish to provide virtual testimony must enter the virtual queue by raising their hand before the queue closes. The queue will close when the last virtual speaker finishes speaking or five minutes after in-person testimony ends, whichever happens first.

Those participating virtually may NOT cede time to others participating in person or virtually.

#### **HOW TO PROVIDE WRITTEN COMMENTS:**

For Agenda Items and Non-Agenda Public Comment: Submit using the webform, indicating the comment type and item number (if relevant). Comments must be submitted the business day prior to the meeting to be distributed to the Hearing Officer and posted online with the meeting materials. All webform comments are limited to 200 words but may include attachments. Comments received after the deadlines described above but before the item is called will be submitted into the written record for the relevant item. Please go to the Hearing Officer website for further instructions.

<u>Written Materials:</u> Instead of submitting materials as an attachment to the <u>webform</u>, you may submit via U.S. Mail to the Hearing Officer at 1222 First Avenue, MS 501 San Diego, CA 92101. Materials submitted via U.S. Mail must be received the business day prior for it to be distributed to the Hearing Officer.

Please Note: Documents related to the Hearing Officer meeting agenda items which are distributed to the Hearing Officer prior to the meeting are available for public review at the Development Services Department Building, 1222 First Avenue, 1st Floor, San Diego, CA. 92101.

## **Late-Arriving Materials:**

# ITEM 1: \*5150 UNIVERSITY AVENUE SELF-STORAGE - PROJECT NO. 0682226

**Staff:** Travis Cleveland **City Council District:** 9 **Plan Area**: City Heights

Variance and Public Service Easement Vacation for a new 141,450-square-foot, two-story self-storage building with a full basement along with the vacation of a sewer easement and a storm drain easement. The 2.17-acre project site is at 5150 University Avenue in the CC-5-4 zone within the Mid-City: City Heights Community Plan. Negative Declaration PRJ-0682266. Report No. HO-24-025.

ITEM 2: WHALE WATCH WAY - PROJECT NO. 1079879

Staff: Christian Hoppe City Council District: 1 Plan Area: La Jolla

Coastal Development Permit and Site Development Permit for a remodel and addition to an existing 4,226 square-foot three-story with basement single dwelling unit by adding 5,209 square feet for a total of 9,435 square feet. The 0.45-acre site is located at 8421 Whale Watch Way in the LJSPD-SF Zone, Coastal Height Limit Overlay Zone, Coastal Overlay (Non-Appealable Area) Zone, and the Parking Impact (Campus and Coastal) Overlay Zone within the La Jolla Community Plan area. This project was determined to be categorically exempt pursuant to Section 15303 (New Construction or Conversion of Small Structures) of the California Environmental Quality Act Guidelines. Report No. HO-24-027.

ITEM 3: ENCLAVE PARK - PROJECT NO. 1070661

**Staff:** Christian Hoppe **City Council District:** 1 **Plan Area**: Torrey Pines

Coastal Development Permit and Site Development Permit to demolish seven single-story buildings and construct a nine-story, 300,000-square-foot research and development building and seven-story parking structure containing approximately 716 parking spaces. The 5.39-acre site is located at 4202 Sorrento Valley Boulevard in the IL-3-1 zone, the Airport Land Use Compatibility Overlay Zone (MCAS Miramar), Airport Influence Area Overlay Zone (MCAS Miramar-Review Area 1), Airport Safety Zone (Accidental Potential 2 Portion 7 Transition Zone), Brush Management Zone, Coastal Overlay Zone (Appealable Area), Special Flood Hazard Areas (100-Year Floodway and 100 Year Floodplain), Prime Industrial Lands (PIL), Multiple Habitat Planning Area (MHPA), Parking Impact Overlay Zone, Transit Priority Area (PSTPA), Very High Fire Severity Zone (VHFSOZ), and Transit Priority Area (TPA) within the Torrey Pines Community Plan area. This project was

determined to be categorically exempt pursuant to Section 15183 (Projects Consistent with a Community Plan or Zoning) of the California Environmental Quality Act Guidelines. Report No. HO-24-024.
