NOTICE OF RIGHT TO APPEAL ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION

COMMUNITY PLAN AREA: COUNCIL DISTRICT: LOCATION:	Downtown Council District 3 1200 Third Avenue, San Diego, CA 92101
PROJECT DESCRIPTION:	This is a license agreement between the City of San Diego (City) and Brooklyn Dogs (Licensee) for the exclusive use of the License Area (City real property commonly known as Civic Center Plaza), located at 1200 Third Avenue, San Diego, California 92101. Licensee and City desire to enter into this Agreement to provide Licensee certain limited rights to undertake the Permitted Use or the operation of one (1) mobile hot dog vending cart and incidental equipment for a period of three (3) years.

ENTITY CONSIDERING PROJECT APPROVAL: City of San Diego

ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION: Categorically exempt from CEQA pursuant to State CEQA Guidelines Section 15301 (Existing Facilities).

ENTITY MAKING ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION: City of San Diego Mayor-Appointed Designee.

STATEMENT SUPPORTING REASON FOR ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION:

The City of San Diego conducted an environmental review that determined the project would not have the potential for causing a significant effect on the environment pursuant to State CEQA Guidelines Section 15301 (Existing Facilities), which allows the operation, repair, maintenance, permitting, leasing, licensing, or minor alteration of existing public or private structures, facilities, mechanical equipment, or topographical features, involving negligible or no expansion of existing or former use; and where the exceptions listed in CEQA Section 15300.2 would not apply in that no cumulative impacts were identified; no significant effects on the environment were identified; the project is not adjacent to a scenic highway; no historical resources would be affected by the action. As to the exception for hazardous materials, there are locations identified on GeoTracker and EnviroStor within 1,000 feet of this site. While these locations are listed, the proposed project would not involve ground disturbance, which would expose potential hazardous materials, and as such, would not preclude the use of a CEQA exemption pursuant to Section 65962.5 of the Government Code.

The appeal filing fee must be United States Postal Service (USPS) postmarked) before or on the final date of the appeal.
