NOTICE OF RIGHT TO APPEAL ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION

SPECIAL EVENTS DEPARTMENT

PROJECT NAME: Special Event Permit - Bike MS Bay to Bay

COMMUNITY PLAN AREA: Torrey Pines, La Jolla, Pacific Beach, Peninsula, University City, Mission Bay

COUNCIL DISTRICT: 1, 2

LOCATION: City roadways as shown on attached maps, Liberty Station

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Special Event Permit for that portion of a bike ride that would occur within the City of San Diego's jurisdiction (route shown on attached maps and turn by turn description).

Within the City's jurisdiction, the event would include the temporary use of the bike route, a rest area, performances, sound amplification, generators, fenced in beer garden, fences and/or barriers, onsite food preparation, food trucks, portable restrooms, canopies, tables, and chairs that would occur on October 20, 2024. Noise associated with the event activities and set-up/dismantling would occur from 4 AM on October 19, 2024, until 7 PM on October 20, 2024. Set-up would occur on October 19, 2024, from 4 AM to 5 PM. On October 20, 2024, the event would occur from 9 AM to 3 PM, and dismantling would occur from 3 PM to 7 PM. The portion of the 2-Day bike route within the City's jurisdiction is indicated on the turn-by-turn moves attached for the 40 mile and 50-mile bike rides.

Participants would follow rules of the road and road closures would only occur once they reach Liberty Station. Road closures are associated with the event that would occur on October 20, 2024, from 5 AM to 5 PM are as follows: Cushing Road from Dewey Road to Roosevelt Road.

ENTITY CONSIDERING PROJECT APPROVAL: City of San Diego

ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION: Categorically exempt from CEQA pursuant to State CEQA Guidelines Section 15301 (Existing Facilities); Section 15304 (Minor Alterations to Land); Section 15311 (Accessory Structures).

ENTITY MAKING ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION: City of San Diego Mayor-Appointed Designee

STATEMENT SUPPORTING REASON FOR ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION: The City of San Diego conducted an environmental review that determined the project would not have the potential for causing a significant effect on the environment pursuant to State CEQA Guidelines Section(s): Section 15301 (Existing Facilities) which allows for the operation, repair, maintenance, permitting, leasing, licensing or minor alterations of existing public or private structures or facilities involving negligible or no expansion of use; Section 15304 (Minor Alterations to Land) which allows for minor, temporary use

of land that has negligible or no permanent effects on the environment; Section 15311 (Accessory Structures) which allows for construction, or placement of minor structures accessory to existing commercial, industrial, or institutional facilities, including, but not limited to, temporary use items in publicly owned facilities or other facilities designated for public use; and where the exceptions listed in CEQA Guidelines Section 15300.2 would not apply in that no cumulative impacts were identified; no significant effects on the environment were identified; the project is not adjacent to a scenic highway; no historical resources would be affected by the action; and the project was not identified on a list of hazardous waste sites pursuant to Section 65962.5 of the Government Code.

Bring the fully completed appeal application DS-3031 (including grounds for appeal and supporting documentation) to the City Administration Building— Public Information Counter (Open 8:00am to 5:00pm Monday through Friday excluding City approved holidays), 1st Floor Lobby, located at 202 C Street, San Diego, CA 92101, by 5:00pm on the last day of the appeal period. The completed appeal form shall include the required appeal fee, with a check payable to: City Treasurer.


