ITEM 1: 4811 MT. ETNA DRIVE - PROJECT NO. 1059048

Plan Area: Clairmont Mesa

Conditional Use Permit (CUP) to amend CUP No. 8276 for the phased demolition of an existing church facility and the phased construction of an educational facility to include three two-story buildings totaling 15,873 square feet, for 12 classrooms for infant care to fifth grade, a rooming house as an accessory use to the educational facility for short-term stays for traveling teachers in accordance with SDMC Section 131.0125(b), and associated site improvements. The development of the proposed project would occur in four phases. The 1.2-acre site is located at 4811 Mount Etna Drive in the RS-1-7 (Residential-Single Unit) zone, the Airport Land Use Compatibility Overlay Zone (ALUCOZ) for Marine Corps Air Station (MCAS) Miramar and Montgomery Field, the Airport Land Use Compatibility Plan (ALUCP) Airport Influence Area (AIA) Review Area Two for MCAS Miramar and Montgomery Field, the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) Part 77 Noticing Area, the Clairemont Mesa Height Limit Overlay Zone (CMHLOZ), and a Transit Priority Area within the Clairemont Mesa Community Plan area.

This project was determined to be categorically exempt pursuant to Section 15332 (In-fill Development) of the California Environmental Quality Act. Report No. HO-24-038.

# ITEM 2: 4165 WILSON AVENUE - PROJECT NO. 1087442

Plan Area: Mid-City

Map Waiver to convert a two-story duplex and one single-dwelling unit (under construction) into three condominium ownerships. The proposed project is on a 0.14-acre site located at 4165 Wilson Avenue in the RM-1-2 base zone, Airport Land Use Compatibility (San Diego Interna Airport) Overlay Zone, Transit Area Overlay Zone, Transit Priority Area (TPA), the San Diego International Airport - Review Area 2 (AIA), and the FAA Part 77 Noticing Area within the City Heights Neighborhood of the Mid-City Community Plan area.

This project was determined to be categorically exempt pursuant to Section 15332, In-Fill Development Projects, of the California Environmental Quality Act. Report No. HO-24-042.

# ITEM 3: 4078 STEPHENS STREET - PROJECT NO. 1075228

Map Waiver to convert three existing units on one parcel into condominium ownership. The 0.15-acre project site is located at the intersection of W. Lewis Street and Stephens Street in the single-unit, RS-1-7 base zone of the Uptown Community Plan area. The project site is comprised of two (2) existing one-story detached units located at 4072 and 4078 Stephens Street, and one (1) existing one-story commercial building located at 1705 W. Lewis Street on a single parcel identified as APN 443-4621100.

This project was determined to be categorically exempt pursuant to Section 15315 (Minor Land Divisions) of the California Environmental Quality Act. Report No. HO-24-044.

When the Hearing Officer indicates it is your turn to speak, unmute your phone by tapping the unmute button on your computer, tablet or Smartphone, or dial \*6 on your phone.

Please Note: Members of the public who wish to provide virtual testimony must enter the virtual queue by raising their hand before the queue closes. The queue will close when the last virtual speaker finishes speaking or five minutes after in-person testimony ends, whichever happens first. Those participating virtually may NOT cede time to others participating in person or virtually.

**Written Materials:** Instead of submitting materials as an attachment to the <u>webform</u>, you may submit via U.S. Mail to the Hearing Officer at 1222 First Avenue, MS 501 San Diego, CA 92101. Materials submitted via U.S. Mail must be received the business day prior for it to be distributed to the Hearing Officer.

# **Late-Arriving Materials:**

Pursuant to the Brown Act, California Government Code Section 54957.5(b), late-arriving documents related to the Hearing Officer meeting agenda items which are distributed to the legislative body prior to and during the meeting are available for public review at the Development Services Department Building, 1222 First Avenue, 3<sup>rd</sup> Floor, San Diego, CA. 92101.
