- Diane Moss and Ian Moreland discussed developing a community garden in Mountain View Park and presented the following information:
  - Map with location of garden/orchards
  - How the community garden would operate and who would operate it
  - Funding source would be grants
  - Someone would need to be appointed to administrate the general plan amendment that P&R would require to add a community garden
  - Vicki Granowitz from the San Diego Parks Foundation attended as a guest to advise that the Linda Vista Community Garden was the only one installed so far on dedicated parkland which is more complicated than installing a community garden on privately owned land. She advised that it took 8 years to complete the garden at Linda Vista Park due to entitlements and a GDP needed and that it takes a minimum of 2 years to get through the entitlement process with the city. The San Diego Parks Foundation is producing a white paper in the next 3 months to document the process at Linda Vista Park and how it should be implemented in other parks going forward and Vicki recommended that the Mountain View CRG await the outcome of that white paper before voting to proceed with a community garden.
