## WHAT DO COMMUNITY PLANNERS IN THE CITY PLANNING DEPARTMENT DO?

- A community planner is assigned to each **planning area** within the City of San Diego.
- Attend <u>planning group</u> meetings, address questions and take feedback concerning the <u>General Plan</u>, <u>community</u> <u>plans</u> and other City land use plans and policies from community members in their assigned communities.
- Reach out to planning group chairs monthly to offer support.
- Review larger and more complex proposed development projects that require a decision on consistency with the <u>General Plan</u> and <u>community plans</u>, generally items heard by the <u>Planning Commission</u> and <u>City Council</u>.
- Prepare updates and amendments to <u>community plans</u>, the <u>General Plan</u>, zoning and development regulations and other City land use plans.

## HOW DO COMMUNITY PLANNERS SUPPORT PLANNING GROUPS, THE COMMUNITY PLANNERS COMMITTEE, AND COMMUNITY MEMBERS IN GENERAL?

- Serve as single point of contact for <u>planning group</u> inquiries about land use or other related matters and engage in productive, meaningful and respectful communication with community members.
- Share information about what the City Planning Department is working on throughout the year and Attend **planning group** meetings in-person 3 to 4 times throughout the year.
- Maintain contact with and address questions from their assigned <u>planning group</u> related to <u>Council Policy 600-24</u> which explains the operating procedures and responsibilities of recognized planning groups.

### HOW ARE CITYWIDE PLANNING AND ZONING INITIATIVES SHARED WITH COMMUNITY PLANNING GROUPS?

- Planning staff also provides support the Community Planners Committee, which is composed of chair, or officially designated representative of each recognized **planning group**.
- Land use issues that are citywide and regional in scope are shared with the Community Planners Committee for review and recommendation per **Council Policy 600–09**.



# WHO CAN HELP ANSWER QUESTIONS ON ZONING, PERMITS, AND THE CITY'S DEVELOPMENT REVIEW PROCESS?

- The <u>City of San Diego Development Services Department</u> oversees the <u>review, permitting, and inspections</u> of development projects.
- Community planning groups and the public may <u>contact</u>
   <u>Development Services</u> to ask questions about <u>zoning</u> and development <u>regulations</u> specific to a particular development project.
