NOTICE OF RIGHT TO APPEAL ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION

SPECIAL EVENTS DEPARTMENT

PROJECT NAME: Special Event Permit - Holiday Bowl 5K

COMMUNITY PLAN AREA: [Downtown](#)

COUNCIL DISTRICT: 3

LOCATION: North Harbor Drive and Embarcadero Walkways (see attached map)

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Special Event Permit for that portion of a 5K Run/Walk event that would occur within the City of San Diego's jurisdiction that would occur along Harbor Drive and the Embarcadero pathways on December 27, 2024. The event would include the walk/run route (see attached map), sound amplification, tents, generators, fencing and/or barriers, tables and chairs. The estimated number of attendees would be approximately 800. Noise associated with the event activities and set-up/dismantling would occur from 5 AM until 2 PM on December 27, 2024. Set-up would occur from 5 AM until 9 AM, the run/walk would occur from 9:45 AM until 11:30 AM, and dismantling would occur from 11:30 AM until 2 PM.

There are road closures associated with the race and would occur on December 27, 2024, 9 AM to 10:30 AM and would include: Harbor Drive between Pacific Highway to Ash

All parking along harbor dr. from Ash Street to Pac hwy.

Pacific Highway Grape St to Beech Street West side

Pacific Highway Broadway and Harbor Drive Both sides

E St Pacific Highway and Dead-end Both sides

F St Pacific Highway and Dead-end Both sides

G St Pacific Highway and Dead-end Both sides

Grape Harbor and Pacific Highway South side

Broadway Harbor to Pacific Both Sides

Harbor Dr Ash St to Broadway Both Sides on December 27, 2024, 4 AM to 2 PM.

STATEMENT SUPPORTING REASON FOR ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION: The City of San Diego

conducted an environmental review that determined the project would not have the potential for causing a significant effect on the environment pursuant to State CEQA Guidelines Section(s): Section 15301 (Existing Facilities) which allows for the operation, repair, maintenance, permitting, leasing, licensing or minor alterations of existing public or private structures or facilities involving negligible or no expansion of use; Section 15304 (Minor Alterations to Land) which allows for minor, temporary use of land that has negligible or no permanent effects on the environment; Section 15311 (Accessory Structures) which allows for construction, or placement of minor structures accessory to existing commercial, industrial, or institutional facilities, including, but not limited to, temporary use items in publicly owned facilities or other facilities designated for public use; and where the exceptions listed in CEQA Guidelines Section 15300.2 would not apply in that no cumulative impacts were identified; no significant effects on the environment were identified; the project is not adjacent to a scenic highway; no historical resources would be affected by the action; and the project was not identified on a list of hazardous waste sites pursuant to Section 65962.5 of the Government Code.

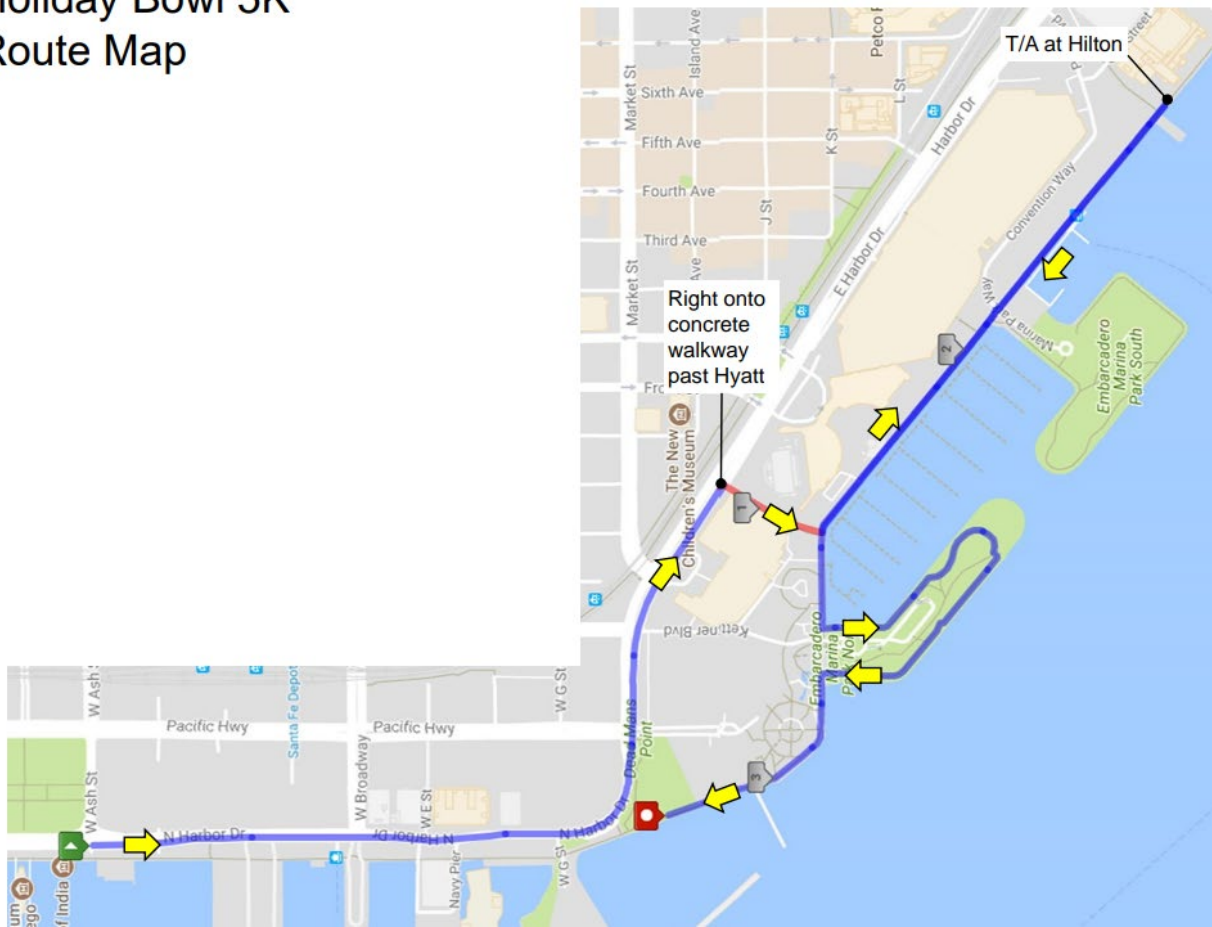
Applications to appeal CEQA determination to the City Council must be filed with the Office of the Clerk within 10 business days from the date of the posting of this Notice (**December 10, 2024**). Appeals to the City Clerk must be filed via email or in-person as follows:

1. Send the completed appeal form (including grounds for appeal and supporting documentation in pdf format) by email to Hearings1@sandiego.gov by 5:00p.m. on the last day of the appeal period; your email appeal will be acknowledged within 24 business hours. You must separately mail the appeal fee by check payable to the City Treasurer to: City Clerk/Appeal, MS 2A, 202 C Street, San Diego, CA 92101. The appeal filing fee must be United States Postal Service (USPS) postmarked) before or on the final date of the appeal.
2. Bring the fully completed appeal application DS-3031 (including grounds for appeal and supporting documentation) to the City Administration Building— Public Information Counter (Open 8:00am to 5:00pm Monday through Friday excluding City approved holidays), 1st Floor Lobby, located at 202 C Street, San Diego, CA 92101, by 5:00pm on the last day of the appeal period. The completed appeal form shall include the required appeal fee, with a check payable to: City Treasurer.

Course Narrative

Start -

Near the intersection of Harbor Dr. & Ash St.

The runners will head south in the S/B lanes of Harbor Dr.

At Broadway, the runners will use the entire road.

At Pac Hwy, the runners will be coned into the N2 & N3 lanes

At Kettner Blvd., the runners will be coned into the N2 & N3 lanes

At Market St., the runners will be coned into the N2 lane

After the Hyatt (before the Marriott) runners turn right onto concrete walkway heading West to the Promenade

At the water runners head South to the Hilton Hotel and Turn around heading North along the waterside.

At the marina walkway, the runners will be directed west onto the walkway

At the EMPN runners turn left circumnavigating Embarcadero-Marina Park North

The runners will continue north on the walkway finishing just south of G St.
