- ☐ Be 16 years old or more and able to read, write, understand English

- ☐ [Become a certified pilot](#)
- ☐ [Submit a request for airspace authorization >60 days prior](#)
- ☐ [Determine if you need an operational waiver](#)
- ☐ [Follow Part 107 Rules](#)
- ☐ Complete City of San Diego Filming Registration
 - Copy of Pilot/Operators FAA Part 107 license
 - Drone make/models# and FAA registrations #
 - Map of planned flight operations including take off/landing/safety exclusion areas
 - Copy of FAA Waiver for restricted airspace areas (if flown in areas requiring FAA preclearance)
 - Drone specific insurance
