

What do I need to fly commercially in San Diego?

	Be 16 years old or more and able to read, write, understand English
	Register your drone with the FAA
	Download the AirHubPortal mobile app
	Learn the rules (<u>Federal</u> , <u>State</u> , and <u>Local</u>)
	Become a certified pilot
	Submit a request for airspace authorization >60 days prior
	Determine if you need an operational waiver
	Follow Part 107 Rules
	Complete City of San Diego Filming Registration
	 Copy of Pilot/Operators FAA Part 107 license
	 Drone make/models# and FAA registrations #
	 Map of planned flight operations including take off/landing/safety
	exclusion areas
	 Copy of FAA Waiver for restricted airspace areas (if flown in areas
	requiring FAA preclearance)
	 Drone specific insurance
