**DEPARTMENT PROCEDURE AFFECTED**: 7.01

Portions of this document are deemed by the San Diego Police Department to be exempt from public disclosure because the public interest served by not disclosing the information clearly outweighs the public interest served by disclosure, pursuant to California Government Code section 7922.000.

**Effective July 1, 2024,** California Assembly Bill 256 amended the California Vehicle Code (CVC) to reflect that CVC 4000, CVC 5204, and CVC 40225 can only be enforced as the sole basis of any enforcement action after two months past the end of the month of expiration. Enforcement action for a violation of these codes may be taken before the two months following the month of expiration if a vehicle is stopped for any other violation of the Vehicle Code.

For example: An expired registration for a registration tag that shows January (JAN) and 2024 would not be enforceable until April 1, 2024.
