The Annual Shotgun Qualification Shoot will begin **September 30, 2024 and will conclude October 11, 2024**. Sworn officers who have been issued a Department Shotgun must attend one of the qualification shoots with the issued Department Shotgun for inspection. Failure to do so will result in the officer having to surrender the issued shotgun to the Range staff. Sworn officers who choose to carry their personally owned approved shotgun must attend one of the qualification shoots. Failure to do so will result in the officer not being able to carry their personally owned shotgun in the field. Sworn officers who choose to stay current with the Department Remington 870 Shotgun platform may use one of the Range's shotguns to qualify.

Qualification Shoots will be posted on Success Factors under "Shotgun Qualification Shoot". Immediate supervisors will ensure their personnel who carry Department issued/personally owned shotguns will attend.

All personnel must arrive at least 15 minutes early to allow enough time for weapon inspections. Please bring all previously issued rounds to use during training. New rounds will be issued after qualification. Personnel who arrive late may be turned away and instructed to re-schedule the training.

All personnel must supply their own eye protection. Sunglasses are not allowed to be used indoors at Poway Weapons and Gear.

In order to comply with (Redacted – record exempt) rules and regulations the following protocol will be followed:

-Sworn Personnel will park in the parking lot furthest from the front door of the business. Personnel will wait in their cars until the scheduled time. -At the start of the shoot, Range Officers will walk out and gather everyone signed up, ensure everyone's shotguns are un-loaded, then escort everyone into the firing range.

-Once the qualification shoot is finished, Range Officers will escort everyone back out to their vehicles.

-If any Sworn personnel arrives late to the shoot, they WILL NOT enter PWG with a shotgun.

<u>Personnel not in compliance with the above instructions, including unauthorized</u> <u>modifications to holsters, weapons, and accessories, will be required to correct the</u> <u>equipment deficiencies and re-schedule the shoot at a later date.</u>
