**DEPARTMENT PROCEDURE AFFECTED**: 1.12

Portions of this document are deemed by the San Diego Police Department to be exempt from public disclosure because the public interest served by not disclosing the information clearly outweighs the public interest served by disclosure, pursuant to California Government Code section 7922.000.

Toll fees are collected for all vehicles on all California toll roads. Drivers of any San Diego Police Department vehicle or any other City vehicle, <u>including emergency vehicles and those with "exempt" license plates must pay a toll fee</u>, except in certain limited circumstances as noted in OR 24-22R.

**Effective immediately**, drivers of department vehicles with "non-exempt" plates using any toll road will be responsible for completing a "Toll Road Usage Notification" form. If use of the toll road DOES NOT meet the Commanding Officer's approval, the department member will be responsible for paying the toll road violation. Examples of approved uses are surveillance operations or in emergency situations. The completed form will be submitted to Operational Support via e-mail at (**Redacted – record exempt**). **The form can be found in the Resource Library under Investigative Resources/Toll Road Usage Notification Form.**
