Golf Course Drive Improvement (WBS- S15040)

Project Background

- Initiated in Fiscal Year 2016 as a feasibility study
- Project initial scope to widen Golf Course Drive between 26th Street and 28th Street to install additional travel lanes, bike lanes, and sidewalk.
- In 2019, a design-only project was initiated for alignment in accordance with the new clubhouse master plan to cut through the golf course within the "horseshoe" segment, enabling the potential construction of a future clubhouse.



Project scope:

Inputs received from the City of San Diego Park and Recreation Department, Greater Golden Hill Community Planning Group (GGHCPG), Balboa Park Committee, and Municipal Golf Committee.

The project is currently scoped to provide design for the following features:

- New roadway through “horseshoe”
- Retaining wall
- Bike lanes
- Driveways
- Sidewalk
- Rapid flashing beacon pedestrian crossing
- Drainage facility
- Street lighting
- Fencing
- Landscape, etc.



Current Status:

- Project is currently in final design
- Project is currently in the environmental permitting approval process
- Project construction schedule is currently being coordinated with Balboa 9-hole golf course project
