# **CITY HALL UPDATES**

## **<u>Tijuana River Valley Letter to President Biden</u></u>**

Last month, I held a press conference in City Hall alongside my colleagues to speak on the issue of the Tijuana River Valley sewage crisis. Later that day, the San Diego City Council unanimously approved my resolution.

Mayor Todd Gloria and City Clerk Diana Fuentes joined me in signing our resolution that the City Council unanimously approved urging the federal government to enact a national emergency for the Tijuana River Valley sewage and pollution crisis to fully fund the EPA's Comprehensive Infrastructure Solution for the Tijuana River Valley.

Shortly after, my office wrote a letter to President Joe Biden urging him to take the necessary steps to enact a national emergency regarding this environmental disaster.

### <u>MTS and District Attorney to</u> <u>Launch Campaign to Combat</u> <u>Wildcatting</u>

I had the pleasure of speaking alongside my colleagues at MTS's and the District Attorney's Wildcatting Campaign Launch Press Conference to combat wildcatting at MTS transit centers at the San Ysidro Land Port of Entry and Otay Mesa Land Port of Entry.

Wildcatters, also known as "raiteros" refers to the unpermitted operation of taxis and transportation services, which have had serious implications to our community.

The chaotic and unregulated nature of wildcatting leads to dangerous conditions that threaten the safety of pedestrians.

### <u>Councilmember Moreno</u> <u>Urges SANDAG to Remove</u> <u>SR 125 Tolls</u>

Earlier this month, I was joined by Assemblymember David Alvarez, Mayor John McCann, Councilmember Carolina Chavez, and local South Bay residents to call on SANDAG to remove the SR 125 tolls.

A recent audit has exposed severe flaws in the toll system, including issues with the inaccurate billing. Despite these findings, SANDAG approved a new contract with similar toll operational concerns.

I demand the removal of SR 125 tolls to ensure equity for South County residents and alleviate congestion on local roadways that residents are forced to use.
