SCOPE: ALL MEMBERS OF THE DEPARTMENT

DEPARTMENT PROCEDURE AFFECTED: 6.04, 7.01

Portions of this document are deemed by the San Diego Police Department to be exempt from public disclosure because the public interest served by not disclosing the information clearly outweighs the public interest served by disclosure, pursuant to California Government Code section 7922.000.

Effective immediately, all misdemeanor citations and custodial arrests involving DRAGNET-related criminal activity will be routed to Traffic Division Special Investigations (TSI) <u>unless</u> there is another underlying primary charge (Robbery, Domestic Violence, Battery, etc.). DRAGNET-related criminal activity involving **felony evading, misdemeanor evading, DUI**, **and other vehicle code violations** must be routed to the TSI for investigation.

DRAGNET-related criminal activity includes:

- 1. Speed Contest [23109(a) VC], Reckless Driving [23103(a) or 23103(b) VC], or Exhibition of Speed [23109(c) VC], or Facilitating a Speed Contest or Exhibition of Speed [23109(d) VC]
- 2. Knowledge or act of disabling airbag or passive restraint system [27317 VC]
- **3.** Registration, Smog, License, or Vehicle Insurance Fraud (i.e., submitting known false claims).
- **4.** Evading with an identified vehicle (or partial plate ID) or known suspect. [2801/2802 VC]
- **5.** Felony Vandalism to roadway or property as a result of DRAGNET activities [594 PC].

- **6.** Vehicle Seizure Affidavits as a result of 23103 VC, 23109 VC, or 2800.1/2800.2 VC[14602.7(a) Court Orders].
- **7.** 10751 VC Investigations.

Misdemeanor citations issued to defendants will be uploaded to NETRMS and be sent by interoffice mail to the Traffic Division for processing.
