Monthly SDPD Issues Report - Officer John Briggs, Community Relations Officer
Officer Briggs reported that there were three home burglaries last week on March 8, one on
Meadows Del Mar Rd and one at 6500 Little McGonigle Rd and the third nearby in Carmel
Valley. Officer Briggs reminded the attendees of the need to lock doors, activate security system,
report unusual activity etc. Also available is a real time online system that provides for police
department activity which he posted in the chat.

Ron Sellemi and Tim Guy reported that there has been no criminal activity in or near their communities.

Fire Safe Council - Wildlife Mitigation and Preparedness - (weblink in 2/12/25 DMM Fire Safety Memo)

Derek Reeves reported that he has been working with Morgan Dioli at the county and the application is 90% complete. The next County meeting is in May at which the DMM FSC will most likely be approved. This was followed by a discussion regarding the financing and development of a Website. Lisa Ross has offered to provide assistance. Chairman Metcalf suggested using Friends of Del Mar Mesa for fund raising. Lisa Ross owns DelMarMesa.Org and will work with Derek Reeves. Derek Reeves also raise the matter of the importance and impact of the communities HOA. Ish Khan will forward the most recent contact roster to Derek Reeves. Lisa Ross raised the matter of lack of responsibly for invasive habitat. Brush management is a city program and should be managed in a way that protects habitat while reducing the risk of fire. Diane Korsh expressed her appreciation for Lisa Ross's input on the matter of establishing the DMM FSC. Lisa Ross expressed her concerns for the decades of neglect of the open spaces and the resulting contribution to the risk of fire.
