

**CONSTRUCTION NOTICE**  
**North City Pure Water Pipeline Nighttime Construction**  
**Scheduled on Eastgate Mall**

April 7, 2025

As part of the City of San Diego North City Pure Water Pipeline project, nighttime large-diameter water pipeline installation is scheduled to begin on Monday, April 7, on Eastgate Mall between Miramar Road and Judicial Drive.

During overnight construction, traffic will be detoured and controlled by flaggers as required around the active work zone. Construction will take place Monday through Friday mornings, from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. Eastgate Mall will be open during day, and steel plates will be used to cover open trenches. Construction on Eastgate Mall is expected to take approximately six months.

All businesses will remain open and accessible during construction, please plan additional time when traveling overnight on Eastgate Mall and expect delays. Please follow all posted signage and crew member directions for safety.

The North City Pure Water Pipeline project is one of several major infrastructure projects that are part of Phase 1 of Pure Water San Diego. The pipeline will start on Eastgate Mall and follow Miramar Road to Kearny Villa Road and continue along Candida Street to Via Pasar and Via Excelencia. From there, the pipeline will tunnel under Interstate 15. On the east side of Interstate 15, it will continue along Businesspark Avenue to Carroll Canyon Road and follow Hoyt Park Drive to Meanley Drive before crossing Scripps Lake Drive to the Miramar Reservoir.

The City is committed to clear communication and providing up-to-date information about construction activities. Properties along the project alignment will receive printed notices before work begins near their address, and construction notices will be regularly posted on [scrippsbranch.purewatersd.org](https://scrippsbranch.purewatersd.org).
