

Next Phase of Traffic Control on Clairemont Drive

April 11, 2025

Crews have made progress installing pipeline through the Clairemont Drive and Clairemont Mesa Boulevard intersection during nighttime hours. We appreciate the patience and cooperation of the surrounding residents and businesses throughout this important phase of work.

On Thursday night, April 17, crews will install the next phase of traffic control on Clairemont Drive to allow for pipeline installation. This traffic control will span between Lakehurst Avenue and Clairemont Mesa Boulevard. Once installed, one northbound and one southbound lane of traffic will be maintained through the work zone.

Pipeline installation will take place between 7 a.m. and 4:30 p.m., Monday through Friday. Welding and other work to finalize the pipeline installation will take place between 4:30 p.m. and 11 p.m. This phase of work is anticipated to last approximately 4 weeks.
