Paradise Hills Community Park Trail

Project Description

- The project provides for the environmental analysis, design, and construction of a primitive trail through open space area in the Paradise Hills Community Park.
- This project is consistent with the approved General Development Plan for Paradise Hills Community Park. Public engagement will be comprised of regular updates on the progress of the project to the local Community Recreation Group.

Scope of Work


The proposed upland trail will connect from the new Paradise Hills Native Plant Garden to the public right of way at Inyo Street. Preliminary alignment of the trail has been identified and will likely include the following:

- Four-foot-wide primitive trail approximately 0.5 miles
- Small footbridge
- Trailhead signage

The final trail alignment and design will be determined based on biological and cultural survey findings to avoid or minimize impacts.

Next steps

- Contract awards:
 - Biological Services with  GREATECOLOGY
 - Field reconnaissance (special status plant and animal species)
 - Suggest changes to the trail alignment (if needed)
 - Prepare Biological Technical Report
 - Archeological Services with  RED TAIL ENVIRONMENTAL
 - Archival Research and Outreach to Tribal contacts
 - Archaeological survey with Trail Alignment
 - Survey reporting
 - Significance testing and resource evaluation
 - Construction monitoring



Next steps and Schedule

Summer 2025	Complete studies and Finalize Trail Alignment
Fall 2025	Complete CEQA review
Early 2026	Award contract to construct trail
