This letter is regarding the Skilled and Trained Workforce Requirement for the MBC Improvements (K-21-1867) project. So Cal Industries (So Cal), in addition to the requesting and hiring of skilled and trained apprentices and journeymen from Laborers Local 89 San Diego for work on the project, has a subcontract that does not exceed one-half of one percent of the price of the prime contract and, to So Cal's knowledge, was not a listed subcontractor under Public Contract Code section 4104 or a substitute for a listed subcontractor. Additionally, So Cal's core workers (journeymen) have the same on the job experience as a laborer who graduates from an apprenticeship school. It is our understanding that our core workers would count towards the skilled and trained workforce requirement due to their experience. So Cal should be exempted from the Skilled and Trained Workforce Requirement for the reasons stated above.
