## NOTICE OF RIGHT TO APPEAL ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION

**PROJECT NAME:** Streetlight Installations in Council District 7

**COMMUNITY PLAN AREA:** Linda Vista

**COUNCIL DISTRICT:** 7

**LOCATION:** Two streetlights will be installed along Comstock Street, between Appert Court and Osler Street, and three streetlights will be installed on Osler Street, between Comstock Street and Ulric Street.

**PROJECT DESCRIPTION:** The project will install five new streetlights, including conduit, conductors, pull boxes, streetlight poles, light fixtures, and other associated appurtenances. Excavation depths will be 18 inches for trenching and five feet for streetlight foundations. All work will be entirely within the developed public right-of-way.

ENTITY CONSIDERING PROJECT APPROVAL: City of San Diego

**ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION:** This activity is categorically exempt from CEQA pursuant to CEQA State Guidelines Section 15303 (New Construction or Conversion of Small Structures) and 15304 (Minor Alterations to Land).

**ENTITY MAKING ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION:** City of San Diego Engineering & Capital Projects Department

**STATEMENT SUPPORTING REASON FOR ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION:** The City of San Diego conducted an environmental review and determined that the Project meets the categorical exemption criteria set forth in the CEQA State Guidelines. Specifically, it qualifies under Section 15303 (New Construction or Conversion of Small Structures), which allows for the construction of a limited number of new, small facilities or structures, such as streetlights and other electrical appurtenances. It also qualifies under Section 15304 (Minor Alterations to Land), which permits minor public alterations in the condition of land that do not involve the removal of healthy mature, scenic trees. This includes minor sidewalk restoration, excavation, and backfilling required for the installation of conduit and streetlight foundations. Furthermore, the exceptions listed in Section 15300.2 do not apply to this project.

On May 2, 2025, the City of San Diego made the above-referenced environmental determination pursuant to the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA). Applications to appeal CEQA determinations made by staff to the City Council must be filed in the Office of the City Clerk ten (10) business days from the date of the posting of this Notice. An application to appeal this CEQA determination must be filed by 5:00 p.m. on May 12, 2025. Appeals to the City Clerk must be filed by email or in person as follows:

The appeal filing fee must be United States Postal Service (USPS) postmarked within five (5) business days of the date the appeal is filed.
