Police Investigate Suspicious Death in Colina Del Sol

On Monday, April 28, 2025, at approximately 8:50 p.m., San Diego Police received a call about an unresponsive female at 4325 Euclid Avenue. Officers from Mid-City Division responded and determined the female was deceased. The responding officers conducted a preliminary investigation and contacted the San Diego County Medical Examiner's Office to respond to the scene. There were no obvious signs of trauma, so the Homicide Unit was not contacted. The decedent was transported to the San Diego County Medical Examiner's Office for an autopsy.

On Tuesday, April 29, 2025, investigators learned the victim was involved in an altercation prior to her death. San Diego Police Homicide Detectives are currently working with the San Diego County Medical Examiner's Office to determine the cause and manner of death.

The victim, Jadeline Laurent, is described as a 28-year-old Black female. Jadeline was in a relationship with, possibly married to, Jean Tercier, who is described as a 39-year-old Black male. Tercier is of Haitian descent and is described as 5'11" and 180 pounds. He is a person of interest in this investigation. His whereabouts are unknown. The San Diego Police Department is asking for the public's assistance in locating Tercier.
